

The University of Silicon Valley Master's Degrees Grant Program is designed to provide tuition assistance to eligible students who meet the criteria outlined below. The criteria have been designed to give the Scholarship Selection Committee maximum flexibility in awarding institutional grants. Recipients will be selected without regard to race, color, sex, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, disability or any other legally protected status.

Eligibility Criteria:

The institutional tuition assistance program is available to accepted applicants and currently enrolled and/or attending students who meet the admissions requirements for the University of Silicon Valley. Additionally, applicants must meet all of the stated criteria outlined below to be eligible to apply.

To be awarded the scholarship, students must:

- Be accepted, enrolled, or attending one of the Master's degree programs as the University of Silicon Valley;
- Be enrolled with full-time status of 6 credits or more per term;
- Demonstrate satisfactory academic progress by having a cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 or higher;
- Complete a Grant Application; and
- Provide acceptable documentation to verify eligibility as required; including, but not limited to letter on official letterhead that verifies position/status.

Awarding Process and Rules

- Each applicant must complete a Grant Application and provide acceptable documentation as required.
- All eligible applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee for completeness and accuracy of all information provided.
- Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for the specific grant applied for.
- Of those viable applications, the awards will be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis; and approved recipients will be awarded during the financial aid packaging process.
- Institutional grants will be applied as a credit against tuition and will not be issued to the student in the form of cash.
- Institutional grants are not transferable.
- Institutional grants may not be used in conjunction with other institutional scholarship and grant programs and cannot exceed the direct educational program costs.
- A maximum of one grant will be awarded to eligible students.
- Institutional grants are automatically renewable each academic year providing the student maintains eligibility.
- Continued eligibility requires students to maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress with full-time enrollment of 6 or more credits per term and a CGPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Failure to meet full-time requirements or Satisfactory Academic Progress may result in the reduction or loss of institutional grants.
- Institutional grant awards are for the length of the educational program for a maximum of 5 terms.

All amounts are calculated based on eligibility criteria and determined by established guidelines. Funding for this program is limited, therefore the University of Silicon Valley reserves the right to cancel a scholarship or grant program at any time at its discretion. However, all grants that have been awarded will be honored provided the student continues to meet eligibility.

	Educators' Grant	25% of tuition	The Educators' Grant is for current educators and education administrators who want to continue with graduate coursework. Candidates must be a current primary, secondary, or postsecondary teacher or administrator and enrolled in one of our Master's degree programs. Candidates must have completed an undergraduate degree program at an accredited college or university. Eligible students have the opportunity to receive a grant for 25% of tuition. Students must be enrolled with full-time status of 6+ credits per term and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher. To qualify, applications must be submitted with proof of educator or administrator status (i.e. letter from school on official letterhead that verifies position/status).
	Business Partnership Training Grant	25% of tuition	This Business Partnership Training Grant is for current employees of companies that have a business partnership with USV who want to continue with graduate education. Candidates must be an employee in good standing with a USV business partner and enrolled in one of our Master's degree programs. Candidates must have completed an undergraduate degree program at an accredited college or university. Eligible students have the opportunity to receive a grant for 25% of tuition. Students must be enrolled with full-time status of 6+ credits per term and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher. To qualify, applications must be submitted with verification status (i.e. letter from company on official letterhead that verifies position/status).

Agreement and Signature

I understand that in order to be eligible for institutional grants, I must meet the admissions requirements for the program for which I am enrolled, as well as all of the criteria outlined by the grant program. For continued eligibility, I understand that I must maintain full-time enrollment status and satisfactory academic progress.
