FOR STUDENTS APPLYING FROM OVERSEAS



APPLY TO USV

After completing the application process and being accepted by USV, the College is authorized to issue you a Form I-20.

Prior to issuing a Form I-20, international applicants must fulfill all admission requirements.

TRAVEL TO THE U.S.

You may enter the U.S. no more than 30 days prior to the program start date listed on your Form I-20.

After you receive your F-1 visa you should make travel arrangements.

Students applying from a foreign country must pay their deposit before arriving to the U.S.



APPLY FOR YOUR F-1 VISA

Pay the SEVIS I-901 fee (Student and Exchange Visitor Information System). This may be paid online at the SEVIS Fee Payment information page (http://www.fmjfee.com/).

Make an appointment at the U.S. Embassy (http://www.usembassy.gov/) or Consulate for an interview. Many branches now use an online booking system.

At the interview, you will be asked to show your relevant documents. Interview requirements may vary based on country.



A passport valid for travel to the U.S. and with a validity date at least six months beyond your intended period of stay

Two photographs (2"x 2" or 51x51mm), showing full face, without head covering, against a light background

The letter of admissions from USV

Signed Form I-20 issued by USV

Proof of financial support to cover your education and living expenses for one year (bank statements, affidavits of support, scholarship award letters, etc.)

You will be asked about your educational plans and your plans for returning to your home country. Visit the U.S. Department of State's website (http://travel.state.gov/visa/temp/types/ types_1268.html) for more information about the visa interview.

If the consular officer determines that everything is in order, the officer is authorized to issue you an F-1 student visa.

CHECK IN AT USV
